IN VINO VERITAS

Wine is the spice of life; you do not have to be educated expert to enjoy the wine. Within the frame of our sommelier style wine tasting you will be guided through the history of Roudnice Lobkowitz Winery, we will not only introduce grape varieties and their characteristics but also teach you to evaluate, describe and taste the wine.

The cultivation of wine in the Roudnice region commenced in the 14th century when King Charles IV, father of the Patria (also known as the father of Czech wine), first brought vines from Burgundy to Bohemia. The vineyards were brought into the Lobkowitz family with Roudnice castle in 1603, after Lady Polyxena of Rosenberg, born Pernstein, married Zdenek Vojtech, Prince of Lobkowitz and High Chancellor of the Bohemian Kingdom for three Emperors.

Roudnice wines have continually maintained and developed their distinctive flavour for four centuries. From past decades to the present, they have received countless gold medals and distinctions at various competitions, both at home and abroad, capturing the attention of connoisseurs and achieving a well-deserved place on the market. The wines of Roudnice castle cellars are best known for their unique flavour and lasting quality. They are dry to semi - dry and varieties currently under cultivation include Müller Thurgau, Sylvaner green, Rhine Riesling, Pinot Gris, Blue Portuguese, St. Lawrence, Pinot Noir and Fratava.

Tasting of Roudnice Lobkowitz wines are offered in the castle interiors and cellars.
